Principles of the Charter of the United Nations underlying a comprehensive, just and lasting peace in Ukraine

1. After the eighth preambular paragraph, insert a new preambular paragraph reading:

Noting with concern the continuing supply of weapons by third parties to the zone of conflict that obstructs the prospects for sustainable peace,

2. After operative paragraph 5, insert a new operative paragraph reading:

Calls for the start of peace negotiations;

- 3. After existing operative paragraph 10, insert a new operative paragraph reading:
 - Calls upon Member States to address the root causes of the conflict in and around Ukraine, including legitimate security concerns of Member States;
- 4. After existing operative paragraph 10, insert a new operative paragraph reading:

Also calls upon Member States to refrain from sending weapons to the zone of conflict;
