## **Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives**

### **Report of the Secretary-General**

#### *Summary*

A total of 15 States submitted reports pursuant to paragraph 11 of General Assembly resolution [79/124](#) (see sect. II of the present report).

Three views were received from States pursuant to paragraph 13 of resolution [79/124](#) (see sect. III).

No additional States became participants to the instruments relevant to the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives (see sect. IV) since the previous report on the topic ([A/79/143](#)).

## I. Introduction

1. On 4 December 2024, the General Assembly adopted resolution 79/124, entitled “Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives”. Paragraphs 11, 13 and 14 of the resolution read as follows:

*“The General Assembly,*

*...*

*“11. Urges:*

*“(a) All States to report to the Secretary-General, in a concise and expeditious manner and in accordance with the guidelines prepared by the Secretary-General, serious violations of the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives as well as missions and representatives with diplomatic status to international intergovernmental organizations;*

*“(b) The State in which the violation took place – and, to the extent possible, the State where the alleged offender is present – to report to the Secretary-General, in a concise and expeditious manner and in accordance with the guidelines prepared by the Secretary-General, on measures taken to bring the offender to justice and to communicate, in accordance with its laws, the final outcome of the proceedings against the offender, and to report on measures adopted with a view to preventing a repetition of such violations;*

*...*

*“13. Also requests the Secretary-General to invite States, in the circular note referred to in paragraph 12 (a) above, to inform him of their views with respect to any measures needed or already taken to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives as well as missions and representatives with diplomatic status to international intergovernmental organizations;*

*“14. Further requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its eighty-first session a report containing:*

*(a) Information on the state of ratification of and accessions to the instruments referred to in paragraph 9 above;*

*(b) A summary of the reports received and views expressed pursuant to paragraphs 11 and 13 above.”*

2. By a note dated 8 January 2025, the Secretary-General invited States to report to him pursuant to paragraphs 11 and 13 of resolution 79/124.

3. The present report has been prepared pursuant to paragraph 14 of resolution 79/124.

4. Section II of the report contains a summary of the reports received pursuant to paragraph 11 of the resolution, in chronological order of receipt.<sup>1</sup>

5. Section III of the report contains the views expressed pursuant to paragraph 13 of the resolution, also in chronological order of receipt.

6. Section IV of the report contains information on the status of participation of States, as at 30 June 2026, in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961, the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 1963, and the respective optional protocols thereto, as well as the 1973 Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents.

## II. Reports received from States pursuant to paragraph 11 of resolution 79/124

7. **Mexico** (12 July 2024) submitted information concerning the incidents reported by the Russian Federation on 9 May 2024 (see [A/79/143](#)):<sup>2</sup>

Two threats of possible presence of explosives received by the Embassy of the Russian Federation on 1 and 6 June 2022 were determined by the local authority to be false threats.

The incident on 26 June 2022 was not reported to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and the affected person was not an accredited official of the Embassy.

Regarding the shooting in the vicinity of the Embassy on 8 July 2022, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs expressed its regret and offered support for any action required.

On the reported armed attack near the Embassy on 18 November 2023, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs requested the Department of Public Security of Mexico City to enhance security.

Concerning the attempted robbery of a diplomatic official on 13 March 2024, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs recommended that the Embassy follow up on the complaint filed.

Regarding several requests made by the Embassy in 2022 and 2024 for security reinforcements due to the demonstrations outside the Embassy, enhanced surveillance and patrols were provided by the Mexico City protection unit for embassies, and the unit reported that the demonstrations were peaceful and did not pose a threat to the security of the Embassy. The free expression of ideas, as well as freedoms of expression and assembly, are protected under the Mexican legal system. The demonstrations took place on a Sunday, outside working hours. Therefore, the actions of the city protection unit for embassies were in compliance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations.

The Embassy was reminded of the obligation of its staff to abide by the Mexican legal system, in accordance with article 41 of the Vienna Convention, and was urged to issue a reminder to its staff regarding the need for compliance with the requests of the city protection unit for embassies. The facilities provided for in article 25 of the Vienna Convention must be understood in the context of the Mexican legal framework, since such facilities cannot result in the contravention of local laws.

8. The **Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela** (19 July 2024)<sup>3</sup> reported the following incident concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

On 13 July 2024, there was another set of acts of vandalism targeting the facade of the Venezuelan diplomatic headquarters in New York.

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela categorically rejects and denounces this new attack, which joins the already long list of hostile and unfriendly acts perpetrated by the Government of the United States against the Government of Venezuela.

The Government of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela calls upon the Government of the United States to urgently adopt all the measures necessary, including preventive measures, to have the events in question thoroughly investigated with a view to, firstly, bringing to justice those who encouraged, instigated, organized and/or perpetrated these criminal acts against the premises of the Consulate General of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela in New York, and, secondly, ensuring due compensation for the damage to the facade of the aforementioned premises.

9. The **Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela** (29 July 2024)<sup>4</sup> reported the following incident concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

On 28 July 2024, the Venezuelan Embassy in Buenos Aires was besieged by a mob, spurred on by high-ranking members of the Government of Argentina, including the Minister for Foreign Affairs, International Trade and Worship, H.E. Ms. Diana Mondino, the Minister of Security, H.E. Ms. Patricia Bullrich, and the Minister of Defence, H.E. Mr. Luis Petri, in flagrant violation of their obligations, in particular those arising from the 1961 Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations and the 1963 Vienna Convention on Consular Relations, to safeguard and protect diplomatic headquarters within their jurisdiction.

The events in question occurred on the same date on which the election of the President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela was taking place, including within the Venezuelan diplomatic headquarters, and in which more than 2,500 Venezuelan citizens residing in Argentina were entitled to exercise their right to vote.

Far from safeguarding and protecting the Venezuelan diplomatic headquarters and its staff, in an act of provocation, the local authorities of the receiving State authorized the convening of a “gastronomic day for Venezuelan migrants” near the Embassy, which resulted in acts of violence.

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela categorically rejects and denounces this incident, which joins the list of hostile and unfriendly acts perpetrated by the Government of Argentina against the Venezuelan State. This time, it deliberately failed in its obligation to ensure adequate security and protection of all diplomatic premises on its territory, including Venezuelan diplomatic premises, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the aforementioned Conventions, thereby endangering the physical safety of Venezuelan diplomatic officials and local Embassy personnel.

10. **Argentina** (5 September 2024) submitted information concerning the incident reported by Venezuela on 29 July 2024:<sup>5</sup>

The Argentine Republic categorically refutes the baseless allegations made by the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela and emphasizes that the Government of Argentina at all times respected and complied with its obligations under the aforementioned Conventions in relation to the protection

of the premises and staff of the Embassy and provided the necessary guarantees for the electoral process to take place peacefully and without any interference whatsoever, through the deployment of an extensive security operation by the Ministry of Security of Argentina.

Before the holding of the election, a meeting was organized at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs with the Ambassador of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Stella Marina Lugo Betancourt, during which the security arrangements for 28 July and relevant contact information were communicated to the Ambassador. At the end of election day, there were no reports in the press or formal complaint by the Government of Venezuela to the Government of Argentina indicating that the premises or staff of the Embassy of Venezuela in Argentina had been harmed or threatened in any way.

In contrast to the continued protection provided by the Argentine authorities to Venezuelan premises and staff in Buenos Aires, including after the voluntary withdrawal of Venezuelan diplomatic staff accredited in the country, the Argentine Republic has been affected by the constant breaching by the Government of Venezuela of the security of the premises of its diplomatic mission in Caracas, including through targeted cuts in the electricity supply, which have affected its normal functioning, in violation of obligations under the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations regarding the inviolability of the premises of the mission and the facilities that must be afforded by the receiving State for the functioning of the mission.

These violations are compounded by the fact that all Argentine diplomatic and consular staff were unilaterally expelled from Caracas by the Venezuelan authorities and given only 72 hours to leave the country with their families, making the continued performance of the functions of the mission impossible. In addition, Venezuela has committed a flagrant violation of the Convention on Diplomatic Asylum by denying and continuing to deny the necessary safe conducts that would enable the Venezuelan nationals who have sought asylum at the official residence of the Argentine Republic in Caracas to leave Venezuelan territory, even preventing them from leaving alongside the expelled Argentine diplomats on their departure from Caracas, despite the repeated official requests made by the Government of Argentina since March 2024.

11. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (18 September 2024)<sup>6</sup> reported the following incident concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

“On 17 September 2024, the Israeli occupying regime carried out a premeditated terrorist attack in Beirut by detonating handheld communications devices, which claimed the lives of nearly a dozen people and also left thousands injured, including H.E. Mr. Mojtaba Amani Hamedani, the Ambassador of the Islamic Republic of Iran to Lebanon.

The Islamic Republic of Iran, in the strongest possible terms, condemns such a horrific crime and cowardly terrorist attack by the Israeli regime, which is considered as part of the ongoing aggressions and commission of atrocious crimes by the Israeli regime against Palestinians and other people of the region. The Islamic Republic of Iran reiterates that such terrorist acts constitute gross violations of the fundamental principles of international law and the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations, as well as international humanitarian law and international human rights law.

The Islamic Republic of Iran further reiterates that the terrorist attack by the Israeli regime, leading to the injury of the Ambassador of the Islamic Republic of Iran, further constitutes a flagrant violation of the foundational principle of inviolability of the person of diplomatic representatives as well as the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations and the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents.

Such internationally wrongful acts by the Israeli regime, along with its terrorist act conducted against the diplomatic premises of the Islamic Republic of Iran in the Syrian Arab Republic on 1 April 2024, as abhorrent instances of encroachments upon the principle of inviolability of representatives, jeopardize the safety and security of diplomatic premises and representatives and pose a serious threat to international peace and security.

The international community and the United Nations should firmly act in consequence of the very purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and thus hold the Israeli regime fully accountable for all of its blatant violations and crimes, including its violent and heinous crimes against diplomatic representatives and premises, so as to end the impunity of the Israeli regime and prevent it from perpetrating such crimes.”

12. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (6 December 2024) reported the following incident concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

“On 29 November 2024, the members of the terrorist group known, inter alia, as “Hay’at Tahrir al-Sham”, in the course of the persistent terrorist attacks of the said group against the Syrian Arab Republic in Aleppo, targeted the Consulate of the Islamic Republic of Iran, among others, with short-range projectiles endangering the lives of the members of the consular mission present in the premises in question. Given the imminent life-threatening and violent attacks posed and committed by the terrorist group rendering the performance of functions of the consular mission impossible, the members of the consular mission vacated the premises, subsequent to which the terrorist group conducted an offensive ground attack against and invaded the Consulate of the Islamic Republic of Iran, also resulting in damage to the property. The full extent of the damage inflicted upon the premises could not be assessed due to the ongoing terrorist attacks of the group in Aleppo.

The Islamic Republic of Iran, while condemning, in the strongest possible terms, the terrorist attacks of the terrorist group against the Syrian Arab Republic, also condemns the acts of terrorism and violence of the above-mentioned group against the Consulate of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Aleppo and reiterates that such unjustifiable criminal acts by the terrorist group constitute crimes against internationally protected persons, as envisaged in the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents, while also encroaching upon the principle of the inviolability of missions enshrined in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations.

The Islamic Republic of Iran underlines that the terrorist act of the above-mentioned group could not be justified under any circumstances and, in this regard, highlights that the international responsibility for such encroachments upon the inviolability of the Consulate of the Islamic Republic of Iran is borne by those who purposefully aid the terrorist group, including through material support. The international community and the United Nations should firmly act in consequence of their obligations in countering terrorism to condemn

unequivocally such criminal acts of the said group with a view to promoting the safety and security of consular and diplomatic missions and striving to achieve a world free of terrorism.”

13. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (13 December 2024) reported the following incidents concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

“On 8 December 2024, concurrent with the recent situation in Syria, groups of individuals forcefully intruded on, overran and invaded the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Damascus, which resulted in, among others, forcible opening of the entrances of the premises and storages, and severe damage to and vandalizing of the premises and of property inside the premises in question, including, inter alia, shattering the windows, doors and furniture. Early footage of the attack disseminated online also indicates that the Embassy may have been fired upon.

Given the imminent life-threatening attacks, the members of the diplomatic mission had already vacated the premises. The said groups and individuals also raided and ransacked the Embassy while ravaging various property inside the premises, impairing the dignity of the Embassy and conducting other unlawful acts. The full extent of the attacks and damage inflicted upon the premises and the property related thereto could not be assessed at the present stage due to the ongoing situation in Damascus and other cities in Syria where the missions of the Islamic Republic of Iran are located.

The Islamic Republic of Iran condemns such unlawful acts, which, among others, jointly and separately have encroached upon the principle of inviolability of the mission and its archives and documents, and reiterates that the deplorable acts could not be justified under any circumstances. The Islamic Republic of Iran reaffirms that the inviolability of diplomatic premises, which is also reflected in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, constitutes a foundational principle of relevant international law. The inviolability of diplomatic and consular missions, including the property, archives and documents of the mission and of its members, should be respected in all circumstances, in accordance with international law.

Given the fact that the Embassy suffered two phases of attacks on 8 December 2024 and, in addition to that, the Consulate of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Aleppo was targeted, including by short-range weapons, on 29 November 2024, the Islamic Republic of Iran expresses its continued serious concerns regarding the increasingly deteriorating status of the safety and security of the Iranian diplomatic and consular premises in Syria. Imminent risks of invasion and repetition of attacks in various forms against the Embassy and the consulate may materialize, considering the situation in Syria. In this respect, the Islamic Republic of Iran emphasizes that attacks against its diplomatic and consular premises must be prevented and stopped, and any actions by groups or individuals that might further jeopardize and violate the safety, security and inviolability of the Iranian mission should cease.”

14. The **Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela** (15 January 2025) reported the following incidents concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

Following the triumph of social peace and stability in the country, with the inauguration of His Excellency Nicolás Maduro Moros, President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela on 10 January 2025, a group of individuals buoyed by violent ideologies carried out a series of coordinated actions that

resulted in damage to the infrastructure of at least six Venezuelan diplomatic offices, as follows:

9 January 2025: the official residence of the Ambassador of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela in the Republic of Honduras;

10 January 2025: the Consulate General in Frankfurt, Germany;

11 January 2025: the consular section of the Embassy in Lisbon;

12 January 2025: the Embassy in the Republic of Costa Rica, the Consulate General in Vigo, Kingdom of Spain, and the Consulate General in Medellín, Colombia;

14 January 2025: the Embassy in the Kingdom of Norway.

15. **Norway** (14 May 2025) reported the following incidents:

*Incidents concerning diplomatic and consular missions and representatives in Norway*

*Iranian Embassy*

An unannounced demonstration took place in front of the Embassy on 29 September 2022. Embassy property was damaged, and individuals unlawfully intruded into the outer grounds of the Embassy.

A total of 85 persons were arrested, and charges on 25 counts were brought against nine persons. The Embassy received ex gratia compensation for the damage from the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The Oslo District Court pronounced judgment on 26 November 2024. The convicted persons were given conditional prison sentences and ordered to pay compensation to the Norwegian State through the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the cost of compensating the Iranian Embassy.

The Embassy, with cooperation from the Norwegian authorities, erected a new perimeter fence strengthening the Embassy's own outer protection. The Embassy has received intensified patrolling and other measures by the Oslo Police.

*Venezuelan Embassy*

The premises of the Embassy chancery were subject to an intrusion, theft and vandalism by unknown perpetrators on 15 January 2025. The criminal case and investigation are being handled by the Norwegian Police Security Service.

*Russian Embassy*

The Mission buildings have been given strengthened patrolling by the Oslo Police, and other enhanced protection measures are also in place.

*Israeli Embassy*

The Embassy has been given strengthened patrolling by the Oslo Police, and other exceptional measures are also in place. The heightened risk of incidents of a serious nature is being met. A mechanism for close coordination has been established between the Israeli Embassy and the Embassy Security Office of the Oslo Police District on threat perceptions and appropriate police measures.

*Incidents concerning Norwegian diplomatic and consular missions and representatives*

*Royal Norwegian Embassy in Khartoum*

Armed conflict broke out in the Sudan in April 2023. The Norwegian Embassy (chancery and residence) in Khartoum was hit by gunfire. On 16 April 2023, the Norwegian residence was damaged by a missile. Norway evacuated all diplomatic staff. The Sudan team is based in Nairobi until further notice.

*Royal Norwegian Embassy office in Baghdad*

Protesters attacked the Swedish embassy complex in Baghdad in July 2023. Norway had a diplomatic representation office on site; thus the attack on Sweden had implications for Norway. One diplomat had been evacuated as a precautionary measure.

*Royal Norwegian Embassy in Kinshasa*

On 10 February 2024, a Norwegian diplomat was attacked in Kinshasa while driving a vehicle with diplomatic licence plates. The attack could be linked to protests targeting diplomatic missions (France, United States of America, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Rwanda) and the United Nations in Kinshasa that day.

16. **France** (7 November 2025) reported the following incident concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

On 13 August 2025, the Malian authorities arrested and detained a member of the Embassy of France in Bamako who is duly accredited by the Malian authorities and included in the Malian diplomatic list as Second Secretary at the Embassy, and holds a Malian diplomatic card.

That arrest and detention took place in flagrant violation of article 29 of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, which enshrines the principle of inviolability of diplomatic agents, who “shall not be liable to any form of arrest or detention”.

This situation creates a dangerous precedent for the entire diplomatic community in Mali.

These actions are all the more unacceptable as the French authorities were not informed of the arrest, which was made public on 14 August on national television by the Malian authorities, accusing the diplomatic agent of participating in a conspiracy to “destabilize the institutions of the Republic” and implicating a number of Malian military officers.

France refutes these false and baseless accusations in the strongest possible terms.

France also protests against the deplorable and unacceptable conditions of detention of the diplomatic agent. He is being held in secret, outside any legal framework, and the official media have broadcast his identity and images following his arrest, thereby further violating his dignity, which the receiving State has a duty to protect.

By acting in this way, the authorities of the Republic of Mali are seriously violating their international obligations and, more specifically, the principle of inviolability of diplomatic agents.

As the International Court of Justice has solemnly affirmed, “there is no more fundamental prerequisite for the conduct of relations between States than

the inviolability of diplomatic envoys and embassies, so that throughout history nations of all creeds and cultures have observed reciprocal obligations for that purpose”.

France urges the authorities of Mali to immediately return to compliance with their obligations and release the diplomatic agent in question without delay.

It is not in the interest of any State to allow such practices against diplomatic agents, to which any State could fall victim tomorrow.

17. **Mali** (18 December 2025) submitted information concerning the incident reported by France on 7 November 2025:

The person concerned, registered as Second Secretary at the Embassy of France in Mali, was arrested on 13 August 2025 for complicity in conspiratorial activities aimed at destabilizing the institutions of the Republic of Mali, including support for and facilitation of acts of terrorism, in flagrant violation of his status of diplomatic agent under the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations.

The case involved not only interference in the internal affairs of Mali, but also acts of support for terrorist organizations in the commission of terrorist offences, contrary to the purposes and principles set out in Articles 1 and 2 of the Charter of the United Nations, which stipulate, among other things, that Members of the Organization must fulfil their obligations in good faith.

It was also a violation of the Vienna Convention, the preamble to which states that “the purpose of such privileges and immunities is not to benefit individuals but to ensure the efficient performance of the functions of diplomatic missions as representing States”.

Furthermore, the person concerned flagrantly violated article 41 of the Vienna Convention, which states clearly that “[persons enjoying privileges and immunities] also have a duty not to interfere in the internal affairs of [the receiving State]”. As a result of his violation of those provisions, he is totally deprived of the benefit of said privileges and immunities and is exposed to legal proceedings like any other person.

Consequently, the person concerned, who was arrested while flagrantly carrying out subversive activities, destabilization of the institutions of the Republic of Mali and acts of support for terrorism, in full violation of international treaty provisions, cannot claim the privileges and immunities provided for in the 1961 Convention.

Given the extreme seriousness of the above-mentioned facts, the Government of the Republic of Mali has decided to take legal action in this case and will keep the Secretary-General informed of its progress.

The Government of the Republic of Mali reaffirms its commitment to respect for international law and for its sovereignty.

18. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (6 March 2026) reported the following incident:

“In the course of the criminal aggression by the United States of America and the Israeli regime against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Islamic Republic of Iran, in flagrant violation of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, on 2 March 2026, the United States and the Israeli regime targeted the premises of the Diplomatic Police in Tehran, which led to the destruction of the premises in question. The Islamic Republic of Iran strongly condemns this brazen act of aggression and gross violation.

This deliberate and unprovoked attack against the premises and the official authority responsible for ensuring the protection, safety and security of diplomatic and consular representatives and missions accredited to the Islamic Republic of Iran constitutes a flagrant breach of international law, including the very principles enshrined in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations. The destruction of this facility not only constitutes a violation of Iran's sovereignty and territorial integrity but is also aimed at jeopardizing the effective protection of foreign diplomatic premises and personnel in Tehran."

19. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (10 March 2026 and revised on 9 April 2026) reported the following incident concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

"On 8 March 2026, in a brutal terrorist attack on the Ramada Hotel in Beirut, the Israeli regime deliberately and ruthlessly assassinated four Iranian diplomats who were assigned to the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Lebanon. This heinous crime was preceded by public statements by the spokesperson of the Israeli regime's forces, who publicly threatened to target the official representatives of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Lebanon.

The deliberate assassination of four Iranian diplomats who were serving as official representatives of the Islamic Republic of Iran constitutes a grave terrorist act and a serious breach of international law. Such a heinous crime, which is another manifestation of the Israeli regime's entrenched policy and practice of conducting terrorist attacks against diplomats and diplomatic premises, represents a flagrant violation of the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations, including the prohibition of the threat or use of force, and constitutes a clear violation of the inviolability of diplomats, as also stipulated in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations; this atrocious terrorist attack is a serious violation of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents.

The Islamic Republic of Iran unequivocally and in the strongest possible terms condemns this heinous and cowardly terrorist act committed by the Israeli regime. The Islamic Republic of Iran emphasizes that such a criminal and deeply rooted policy and practice of the Israeli regime in targeting diplomats cannot go unpunished. The perpetrators of this terrorist attack must not be allowed to operate with impunity and must not evade their international criminal responsibility. All perpetrators of this criminal act must be held fully accountable and brought to justice."

20. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (26 March 2026) reported the following incident concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

"From 8 to 13 March 2026, in a series of brutal terrorist attacks in Beirut, the Israeli regime ruthlessly assassinated six Iranian diplomats assigned to the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Lebanon. These heinous crimes were preceded by statements of the spokesperson of the Israeli regime, who publicly threatened to target Iranian official representatives in Lebanon.

The deliberate assassination of six Iranian diplomats constitutes a grave terrorist act and a serious breach of international law. Such a heinous crime represents yet another manifestation of the Israeli regime's entrenched policy and practice of carrying out terrorist attacks against diplomats and diplomatic premises.

The Israeli regime's brutal attacks represent a flagrant violation of the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations, including the prohibition of the threat or use of force, and constitute a clear breach of the very principle of the inviolability of diplomats, as stipulated in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations. Such atrocious terrorist attacks also constitute a serious violation of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents.

The Islamic Republic of Iran unequivocally and in the strongest possible terms condemns these heinous and cowardly terrorist acts committed by the Israeli regime. It further emphasizes that such criminal conduct, as part of an entrenched policy and practice of targeting diplomats and diplomatic premises, cannot go unpunished.

The perpetrators of this terrorist attack must be allowed neither to evade responsibility nor to escape their international criminal responsibility. All the perpetrators of this criminal act must be held fully accountable and brought to justice."

21. **Norway** (16 April 2026) reported the following incidents:

*Incidents concerning diplomatic and consular missions and representatives in Norway*

*United States Embassy*

On 8 March 2026, an explosive device was detonated outside the entrance to the Embassy's Consular Section. The Oslo Police District increased security measures at the Embassy chancery. The criminal case and investigation are being handled by the Norwegian Police Security Service. Several arrests have been made.

*Egyptian Embassy*

The premises of a property owned by the Embassy, which was under renovation and unoccupied, were subject to an intrusion by unknown perpetrators on 15 July 2025. On several occasions, locks were attached to the gate of the property. The police initiated an investigation, but the case was dismissed due to lack of evidence.

Subsequent to a demonstration in front of the Embassy chancery on 31 July 2025, members of the Embassy staff were reported to the police for inflicting bodily harm against two demonstrators. The case was dismissed, with reference to the staff members' immunity from criminal jurisdiction.

Related to the same incident, the Embassy reported the two demonstrators to the police with allegations of violent behaviour and impairment of the Embassy's dignity. The case was dismissed, as the evidence showed that no crime had been committed.

The Embassy reported that, on 10 August 2025, unknown perpetrators attached locks to the gate of the Embassy's chancery. The Embassy removed the locks and notified the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, but not the Oslo Police District. Thus, the police were unable to conduct an investigation.

The Oslo Police District responded to said incidents by temporarily increasing police presence in the vicinity of the Embassy.

*Iranian Embassy*

On 11 January 2026, unknown perpetrators climbed the fence of the Embassy and replaced the flag of the Islamic Republic of Iran with another flag. The Embassy chancery's walls were sprayed with anti-Government slogans.

The Oslo Police District increased security measures at the chancery and the Ambassador's residence. The investigation is ongoing.

*Russian Embassy*

On 2 January 2026, a man climbed over the Embassy's fence. Embassy security guards detained the perpetrator until the police arrived. The police opened a criminal case, which was subsequently dismissed, as the requirements for punishment were not fulfilled.

The Mission buildings have been given strengthened patrolling by the Oslo Police, and other enhanced protection measures are also in place.

*Venezuelan Embassy*

The premises of the Embassy chancery were subject to an intrusion, theft, and vandalism by unknown perpetrators on 15 January 2025. The criminal case and investigation were handled by the Norwegian Police Security Service.

The case was dismissed on 18 August 2025 for lack of information on the identity of the perpetrator(s). The Embassy appealed the dismissal to the National Public Prosecutor's Office. On 13 October 2025, the Office concluded that it had found no reason to reverse the dismissal decision.

*Incidents concerning Norwegian diplomatic and consular missions and representatives**Royal Norwegian Embassy in Tel Aviv*

On 19 June 2025, someone threw a hand grenade into the front garden of the residence of the Ambassador in Tel Aviv, causing material damage. Consequently, the physical protection and video surveillance of the residence had to be strengthened. The incident has been subject to criminal investigation by Israeli police. Norway has reiterated the responsibility of the Israeli Government for the security and safety of diplomatic missions and representatives.

On 2 December 2025, damage to an external network cable to the residence of the Ambassador in Tel Aviv was discovered. The damage appeared to have been carried out with intent, as the network cable had been cut with a sharp object. The incident was reported to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Israel. The investigation was dismissed by Israeli police.

22. **Sweden** (4 May 2026) reported the following incidents concerning diplomatic and consular missions and representatives in Sweden:

31 January 2024: staff at an embassy in Stockholm found a "dangerous object" outside the embassy building, but inside its fenced-off compound. The object was assessed and destroyed by the national bomb squad. A police investigation was initiated.

17 May 2024: a 15-year-old boy was arrested on his way to an embassy carrying a gun and was later sentenced by a Swedish court. The following night, a 14-year-old boy was arrested after a shooting near the same embassy.

27 May 2024: climate activists broke into the premises of an embassy. Five persons were sentenced by Stockholm District Court and ordered to pay damages.

30 September 2024: a man broke into an embassy, smashing windows before hanging a flag from a window. Police entered the building and arrested the man, who was armed with a knife and had barricaded himself in a room. A police investigation was initiated.

1 October 2024: a 16-year-old boy fired a weapon towards an embassy. He is awaiting trial in Stockholm, having been sentenced by local courts in another country for a related incident.

January 2025: a man was arrested following an attempt to forcefully enter embassy premises using a vehicle. A police investigation was initiated.

30 April 2025: an individual set the entrance and a guard booth connected to an embassy on fire. A man was arrested and later sentenced and ordered to pay damages by Swedish courts.

July 2025: a lock was put on the entrance gate of an embassy, and coloured liquid was thrown on the building facade. Police investigations were initiated.

Multiple occasions in 2024 and 2025: drones have been used to overfly the premises of an embassy and drop coloured liquid and waste on the premises. Police investigations have been initiated and targeted police operations have been put in place.

Moreover, several minor incidents were also reported, including demonstrations without permission, low-level threats, petty thefts and fraud, harassment, and damage to embassy premises and property.

24. **Lebanon** (14 May 2026) submitted information concerning the incidents reported by the Islamic Republic of Iran on 26 March and 9 April 2026:

Lebanon reaffirms its adherence to all provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, as well as the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents.

The obligation of protection set forth in articles 22 and 29 of the Vienna Convention constitutes an obligation of conduct. The receiving State is therefore required to exercise due diligence and take all appropriate measures within its power to safeguard diplomatic missions. It is not, however, liable for damages arising from force majeure or from acts attributable to another State engaging in hostilities against it. This is the case with the facts referred to in the memorandum from the Islamic Republic of Iran: the “diplomats” were killed as a result of Israeli bombardments, carried out in the context of repeated and ongoing attacks by Israel against Lebanese territory. Owing to the significant disparity in military capabilities between the two States, Lebanon is unable to prevent Israeli aggression through military means. Nevertheless, the Lebanese State endeavours to halt these attacks by resorting to all available diplomatic and legal means.

The Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents, addresses acts of violence committed by individuals or terrorist groups within the jurisdiction of a single State. Its scope does not extend to the regulation of inter-State conduct in situations of armed conflict.

The Lebanese authorities continue to investigate the circumstances surrounding the killing of the Iranian “diplomats”, as well as the accuracy of their designation. This inquiry is being conducted in light of media reports suggesting that the persons concerned may have been members of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps.

In this regard, the Government of Lebanon reminded the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Beirut, pursuant to article 41 of the Vienna Convention, that the mission premises must not be used for activities contravening the laws and regulations of the host State, nor may its diplomatic personnel interfere in the internal affairs of the State.

The Government of Lebanon further reminded the Embassy of the necessity of applying the Vienna Convention in good faith, a general principle of international law. In the present case, this obligation requires the Iranian Embassy to provide accurate information and genuine descriptions concerning the individuals for whom diplomatic status and protection are being sought.

25. **Finland** (15 May 2026) reported the following incidents concerning diplomatic and consular missions and representatives in Finland:

*Embassy of the Russian Federation*

Between 5 June 2024 and 25 February 2026, the Embassy filed six criminal reports concerning receipt of suspicious letters, two criminal reports concerning entry into the Embassy premises without permission, and one report of an offence regarding setting the flag on fire and hurling it into the Embassy grounds.

*Embassy of the Republic of Belarus*

On 26 April 2024, a parked Embassy vehicle was broken into by shattering the small rear right window, and the inside of the vehicle was soiled and ransacked.

*Embassy of Israel*

Between 14 January 2024 and 23 September 2025, the Embassy filed five criminal reports concerning damage to the Embassy property.

*Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran*

On 12 January 2026, two men went over the Embassy fence, cut down the flagpole and began to tear the flag, while two other men remained outside the fence to film the events. Several red tags were found painted on the outer wall of the Embassy.

*Embassy of the People's Republic of China*

On 30 September 2025, two individuals rode past the Ambassador's residence on an electric scooter, and one of them threw an egg at the door.

*Embassy of the Republic of Türkiye*

A parked Embassy car was damaged.

Finland takes very seriously its duty to take all appropriate action to protect the premises of diplomatic missions against any intrusion or damage, and to prevent any attack on the person of staff members of the missions. Finland also emphasizes the importance of cooperation on security matters between the missions and the competent local authorities.

27. The **United Arab Emirates** (15 May 2026) reported the following incidents:

*Incidents concerning diplomatic and consular missions and representatives in the United Arab Emirates*

Since 28 February 2026, the United Arab Emirates has been subjected to continued unlawful attacks launched by the Islamic Republic of Iran, which have deliberately targeted civilian objects, including buildings hosting diplomatic and consular premises.

Iran is liable for all injury and damage, both material and moral, that it has caused and continues to cause to and in the United Arab Emirates as a result of its unlawful actions.

Iran has targeted several buildings housing diplomatic and consular premises with drones and has conducted attacks in the proximity of these buildings, putting diplomatic and consular premises and representatives at risk. Appropriate measures have been taken by the United Arab Emirates in accordance with its established procedures and obligations under international law. Furthermore, the United Arab Emirates continues with its efforts at the international level to hold Iran accountable for these attacks and continues to take measures to protect its territory, including diplomatic and consular missions and representatives present in its territory.

The following incidents affecting diplomatic and consular missions in the United Arab Emirates have been reported:

(a) On 1 March 2026, a drone attack caused damage to the Etihad Towers complex in Abu Dhabi and injury to a woman and a child;

(b) On 3 March 2026, a drone attack caused damage to one of the Consulate General buildings in Dubai;

(c) On 13 March 2026, a drone attack affecting Dubai International Financial Centre (DIFC) Innovation One Tower, near Index Tower, caused damage to the Index Tower, the DIFC Innovation One Tower and the Central Park Towers Residences;

(d) On 14 March 2026, a drone attack on ICD Brookfield Place, near Index Tower in Dubai, caused damage to the windows of ICD Brookfield Place.

The following diplomatic and/or consular missions were among the buildings that suffered damage due to the drone attacks outlined above: The

Bahamas, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Italy, Israel, Norway, Tonga and the United States, as well as the European Union.

*Incidents concerning the diplomatic and consular missions and representatives of the United Arab Emirates*

*Iraq*

On 9 March 2026, there was a drone attack that targeted the Consulate General of the United Arab Emirates in the Kurdistan Region of Iraq, which resulted in material damage with no injuries reported.

Information indicates that the drone used in the attack broke into pieces and the warhead completely exploded, causing material damage to the building and several vehicles. Further information received indicates that this drone was launched by Iran-backed militias.

On 14 March 2026, there was a drone attack that targeted the Consulate General of the United Arab Emirates in the Kurdistan Region of Iraq, for the second time in a week.

The recovered debris suggests that a drone hit the roof of the building and exploded into pieces, and the debris penetrated a storage room, causing a fire which led to the explosion of its payload. Two personnel were wounded.

The United Arab Emirates has called on the Government of the Republic of Iraq and the Kurdistan Regional Government to investigate the circumstances surrounding both attacks, identify those responsible, and take all necessary measures to ensure that the perpetrators are held accountable.

*Syria*

On 3 April 2026, there were acts of rioting, attempted vandalism, and attacks targeting the Embassy and the residence of the Head of Mission of the United Arab Emirates in Damascus.

The United Arab Emirates called on the Syrian Arab Republic to uphold its obligations to protect the Embassy and its personnel, investigate the circumstances surrounding these attacks, prevent their recurrence and take all necessary legal measures to hold the perpetrators accountable.

*Sudan*

In a letter dated 8 November 2024 ([A/79/604-S/2024/809](#)), the Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates informed the Secretary-General of the heinous attack on 29 September 2024 by the Sudanese Armed Forces on the residence of the Head of the Mission of the United Arab Emirates, which is located in a residential area in Khartoum, near other diplomatic premises. The attack resulted in extensive damage to the building and property.

No discernible measures have been taken to apprehend the offenders and bring them to justice, nor to prevent a repetition of such violations. Despite clear and demonstrable evidence, the Sudanese Armed Forces have not assumed responsibility for this act.

The annex to the letter contains photographs that conclusively prove that the diplomatic premises were attacked.

28. **Armenia** (18 May 2026) reported the following incidents concerning its diplomatic and consular missions and representatives:

*Belgium*

16 November 2023: the luggage of a high-level official of Armenia and a handbag containing documents and diplomatic passports were stolen.

10 June 2024: the Ambassador's bicycle was stolen from in front of the Embassy.

5 November 2024: the Counsellor of the Mission was physically assaulted near Square Meuse, Brussels, by three unidentified individuals who attempted to steal his mobile phone and wristwatch.

17 November 2024: an attempted burglary occurred at the private residence of the Second Secretary of the Mission of Armenia to the European Union.

29. The **Sudan** (22 May 2026) submitted information concerning the incident reported by the United Arab Emirates on 15 May 2026:

The Government of the Republic of the Sudan has previously refuted, with compelling and well-documented evidence, the allegations advanced by the United Arab Emirates concerning the purported targeting of the residence of the Ambassador of the United Arab Emirates in Khartoum. Such allegations were unfounded and were intended to divert attention from the documented crimes perpetuated by the United Arab Emirates against the Sudanese people, such as arming, financing and sponsoring the Rapid Support Forces genocidal militia, which continues to wage a destructive war against the Sudanese State and people.

The involvement of the United Arab Emirates in supporting the Rapid Support Forces militia has been reflected in reports issued by relevant United Nations mechanisms (see [S/2024/65](#)), as well as in numerous investigative reports and media publications by credible international sources. The incessant provision of top-notch drones, arms and logistical support to this militia has directly contributed to the fuelling of the conflict, grave violations of international humanitarian law, and the deterioration of the security and humanitarian situation in the Sudan.

The Rapid Support Forces militia, which is backed by the United Arab Emirates, has systematically targeted civilian infrastructure and has spared no diplomatic premises in Khartoum from looting, vandalism, occupation and destruction. Numerous diplomatic missions accredited to the Sudan have suffered serious violations of the inviolability and protection guaranteed under international law, particularly the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations.

Moreover, the advanced drones and military equipment supplied to the Rapid Support Forces militia by the United Arab Emirates are now being used in attacks extending beyond civilian targets, including against United Nations peacekeepers. In this connection, reference is made to the attack against the base of the United Nations Interim Security Force for Abyei (UNISFA) in Kadugli (see the Security Council press statement on drone attacks on UNISFA peacekeepers of 19 December 2025 (SC/16259)), which represents a dangerous escalation and a direct threat to the safety and security of United Nations personnel and operations.

The Sudan's detailed rebuttal of the aforementioned Emirati allegations and lies has already been circulated in an official document of the General Assembly and the Security Council ([A/79/605-S/2024/831](#)).

The Republic of the Sudan reaffirms its full commitment to, and strict adherence with, all obligations arising under the Vienna Convention on

Diplomatic Relations, including the protection and security of diplomatic and consular premises and personnel.

30. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (22 May 2026) submitted information concerning the incidents reported by the United Arab Emirates on 15 May 2026:

“On 28 February 2026 and on the days that followed, the United States, having had the territory of, inter alia, the United Arab Emirates at its disposal, conducted premeditated aggression, along with its criminal accomplice, the Israeli regime, against the Islamic Republic of Iran. The aggressors, in the course of their blatant and brutal aggression, while killing thousands of civilians, including women and children, and leaving many more injured, also seriously undermined and endangered the safety and security of diplomatic and consular premises, including by targeting or inflicting damage on such premises and diplomatic police.

As a case in point, on 8 March 2026, as a result of the criminal aggression and brutal attacks of the aggressors, the Consulate General of the Russian Federation in Isfahan, Iran, was damaged and its windows were shattered, while several employees were thrown by the blast wave, as reported by the spokesperson of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation.

The aggression of the United States and the Israeli regime against Iran also inflicted material damage on the premises of the World Health Organization (WHO) in Tehran. The damage sustained by the WHO office was due to an aerial attack conducted against civilian objects in the vicinity of the office in question, as reported by the head of the office. The Director-General of the World Health Organization also publicly expressed his concerns regarding strikes damaging the WHO premises in Tehran.

As per the report of the United Nations Resident Coordinator in Tehran, on 31 March 2026, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization field office in Tehran was damaged due to brutal attacks by the United States and the Israeli regime against the precinct where the office was located.

The deliberate targeting of the premises of the diplomatic police in Tehran by the aggressors on 4 March 2026 led to the destruction of the premises in question and seriously undermined and impeded the performance of the duties of the diplomatic police in relation to the safety and security of diplomatic and consular missions.

The Islamic Republic of Iran strongly condemns such brazen acts of aggression and gross violation of the United States and the Israeli regime, and underlines that the said aggressors, along with any country that has placed its territory at their disposal for the war of aggression against Iran, in particular, the United Arab Emirates, should be held fully accountable in accordance with international law for targeting, participating or otherwise wilfully aiding and assisting the aggressors in the commission of all internationally wrongful acts perpetrated in the course of the blatant aggression against the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Iran reaffirms its commitment to the applicable obligations under relevant international law and categorically and unequivocally rejects the unfounded allegations levelled by the United Arab Emirates. Abuse of the processes envisaged in General Assembly resolution [79/124](#) could not deflect attention from complicity in acts of aggression against the Iranian people.

The United Arab Emirates bears full international responsibility for, among others, placing its territory at the disposal of, in particular, the United States for conducting aggression against Iran; a violent, brutal and barbaric

aggression that damaged not only premises related to diplomatic missions and duties pertinent thereto but also thousands of other civilian objects including schools, hospitals, cultural heritage and medical centres.”

31. **Belgium** (2 June 2026) reported 96 incidents concerning diplomatic and consular missions and representatives in Belgium that have occurred since 10 April 2024.

32. The **Islamic Republic of Iran** (24 June 2026) submitted information concerning the report submitted by Lebanon on 14 May 2026:

“The Islamic Republic of Iran reiterates its positions expressed in notes that it has previously submitted pursuant to resolution [79/124](#) concerning the brutal assassination of several Iranian diplomats in Lebanon by the Israeli regime. The killing of these persons enjoying special protection under international law is a matter of serious concern by virtue not only of legal obligations but also of elementary considerations of humanity; these crimes cannot be condoned and must be strongly denounced. Repeating unfounded allegations and false narratives of the Israeli regime against the Iranian Embassy would only embolden the regime in the commission of heinous crimes. Iran reemphasizes the receiving State’s obligations under relevant international law in ensuring the safety, security, privileges, immunities and rights of Iranian diplomats in Lebanon.”

### III. Views expressed by States pursuant to paragraph 13 of resolution [79/124](#)

33. **Guatemala** (26 March 2026)

In view of article 149 of the Political Constitution of the Republic of Guatemala and articles 22, 29 and 30 of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, the State institutions responsible for public security, in particular the National Civil Police, must take the necessary measures to ensure the protection of diplomatic and consular premises and of accredited officials in the country.

Guatemala provides security services through the National Civil Police to diplomatic missions, diplomatic representatives and individuals.

The National Civil Police considers it necessary to standardize risk assessments, formalize coordination with the authorities of international intergovernmental organizations, train the police personnel responsible for the security and safety of diplomatic premises and/or diplomatic and consular representatives, and monitor the aforementioned services.

34. **Mexico** (15 May 2026)

The Department of Public Security of the government of Mexico City is responsible for providing perimeter security for mission premises and official residences in Mexico City. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, through its Directorate General of Protocol, receives and processes requests from missions and mission staff for enhanced protection and submits them to the competent authority.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs provides foreign missions with a Protocol Guide outlining the procedures regarding accreditation and the immunities and privileges to which their staff are entitled. The Guide expressly refers to the spirit of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, namely, the fact that the purpose of “privileges and immunities is not to benefit individuals but to ensure the efficient performance of the functions of diplomatic missions as representing States”.

Chapter III of the Guide provides for missions to submit various types of security requests to the Ministry, through the diplomatic channel, in accordance with articles 22 and 29 of the Vienna Convention, including requests for enhanced security, support for special events, additional external protection for foreign mission premises and official residences, and protection of the private residences of accredited staff.

The Department of Public Security of the government of Mexico City has a dedicated service unit for embassies, which operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

The Government of Mexico gives the highest priority to the protection of Heads of State and Government, as well as high-level foreign officials visiting Mexico. Security is provided by the Ministry of Defence or the National Guard and traffic assistance by the Department of Public Security of the government of Mexico City for visits by the following officials:

- Heads of State and Government and their spouses
- Members of royal families
- Vice Presidents and Deputy Prime Ministers, and their spouses
- Presidents of legislative chambers
- State and provincial governors
- Government ministers
- Secretaries-General and Directors General of international organizations
- The President of the European Commission and European Union commissioners.

35. **Belgium** (2 June 2026)

Based on the threat analysis conducted by the Threat Analysis Coordination Agency for every diplomatic mission in Belgium, the Crisis Centre of the Ministry of the Interior asks the police to make specific security arrangements for each mission. The Crisis Centre holds a monthly meeting to review the security arrangements for various diplomatic missions.

Diplomatic missions and consular posts that have a security problem contact the Protocol Division of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, which informs the competent authorities, primarily the Crisis Centre of the Ministry of the Interior, so that the appropriate security measures can be taken by the relevant police district. The mission in question then always receives an acknowledgement from the Protocol Division, setting out the appropriate course of action to be taken.

Furthermore, whenever the situation so requires, diplomatic missions are invited to file a complaint and are encouraged to send a copy of the report to the Protocol Division. The missions are free to learn the outcome of their complaint by asking the police directly or asking the Protocol Division.

Whenever new Heads of Mission and diplomats arrive in Belgium, the Protocol Division actively participates in various information briefings on established procedures and arrangements for day-to-day cooperation with the Protocol Division, including the procedures for requesting security measures and reporting security incidents.

#### IV. Status of participation in international conventions pertaining to the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives as at 30 June 2026

36. Each instrument listed below is represented in tables 1 and 2 by the letter shown on the left in the list.
